The weekend will follow its usual pattern with workshops during the daytime and dances in the evenings, finishing with tea dances on the Monday afternoon. All workshops and dances will be aimed at experienced dancers; an easy familiarity with the basic dance figures will be assumed. The main emphasis will be on English dancing, there will also be some American as usual, plus a variety of callers presenting their own dances.

Workshops and dances will be held in the Grange Hall, the Graham Adams Centre and Southam Primary School, which are all fairly close together in the centre of Southam. As last year, there will be a third dance on the Friday evening to ensure choice and avoid overcrowding.

Hot and cold drinks will be available at the breaks and the cost of these is included in the ticket price. Following last year's innovation we are asking you to order and pay for sandwiches as part of your booking process to reduce the amount of administration at the weekend. Food can also be found locally for lunch and evening meals.
